### Changing Direction

If you are considering “picking up” a U3 & U4 subject when you have not completed U1 & U2 of the subject, you need to consider the following;

Questions	Yes / No
Read the description of the subject in the VCE Handbook	
Speak to YR12 students currently studying the subject	
Find out more about the subject from the teacher of this subject	
Consider the subject’s relevance to my course / career goals	
Is my level of ability suited to the subject ?– ask a teacher who knows you	
Identify why I’ve had problems in subject I have “dropped”	

You should only consider selecting a new subject if you have answered “yes” to all of these Qs.

### General Points

- All subjects in Yr12 are challenging.
- No subject in Yr12 is easy.
- All Yr12 subjects in Yr12 require you to work hard in class.
- All subjects in Yr12 require you to complete several hours of homework each week.
- Less than 100% attendance disadvantages your overall level of achievement.
- Students do best in subjects they enjoy and are interested in.
- You are an individual and must make choices that work for you.
- Helping you achieve your potential is our concern but your responsibility.
