


Year 10 English

What's English Literature about?

- Literature helps you to understand:
 - the different ways texts are constructed and how authors create meaning with language & structure.
 - the historical and social context of the author, and how it can affect the texts they create.
- We read a LOT more books in Literature, and it expected that you read over the holidays and in your own time.
- VCE (year 11-12) has a Literature subject, and doing it in Year 10 will help you get the foundation you need



If you want to sign up:

Year 10 Literature runs in semester 1, then Year 10 Literature Extension runs in semester 2.

- This means you can do Lit for the whole year if you want!
- OR just have a 'taste' of it in sem 1 and chose something new sem 2



Literature is an English Elective, students must still complete English as part of the Year 10 program
